



# EARLY ENTRANCE TO KINDERGARTEN APPLICATION

Children must be the age of five (5) by August 31 of any given year to enroll in kindergarten. If your child turns five (5) between September 1 and November 30, Central Kitsap School District offers optional Early Entrance Kindergarten testing. Participants will be tested on their academic and social readiness skills. There is a non-refundable testing fee of up to \$325. Central Kitsap School District is not suggesting that inclusion in this screening infers eligibility or readiness, directly or indirectly, for kindergarten. We will contact parents/ guardians to schedule testing. Testing will be scheduled for June. Any family who moves in to CKSD boundary areas over the summer may be eligible for testing in August.
