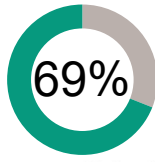

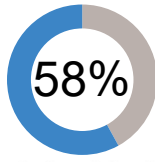

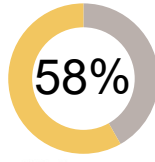

Our school has an experienced staff of certificated teachers and classified support employees. Many members of our staff have specialized training, and 80% of our teachers have taught for five or more years.

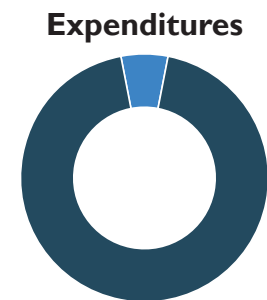

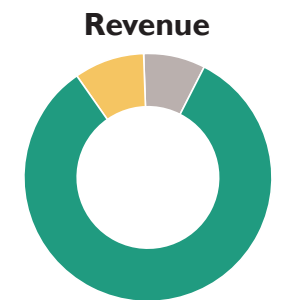
