Important Reminders regarding electives

It is very important that you select more than 2 electives in Genesis and put them in order of preference. We will do our best to get your first and second choice. You **NEED** to list backup electives! This will ensure you get an elective that you would like to take. Students that do not list backups will be put into electives that are available.

Seniors that would like a senior free and juniors/sophomores that would like a study hall, please notify your counselors when you meet with them. You cannot select this option in Genesis.

***All students must be enrolled in at least 6 credits at all times.**
