To the Parents of Brooklawn Middle School Students,

The Traffic Section of the Police Department received complaints of an ongoing traffic build up on Littleton Rd at the end of the school day. This build up of traffic is caused when the entrance way of the school fills to capacity and parents wait in line along Littleton Rd, blocking the northbound travel lane. As vehicles stack on Littleton Rd, this creates a potentially hazardous condition and places everyone including pedestrians and other motorists at risk. This stretch of roadway is posted at 35 miles per hour and as traffic halts there is the danger of "fender bender" accidents or even more serious crashes at the end of the line. The Police Department can not allow vehicles to block the lane, even for a few minutes, as waiting in this line is a violation of NJ Traffic Statue 39:4-56.

We understand that children need to be picked up after school and we suggest that when the line is full, vehicles continue on Rt 202 and wait across the street on Fairhaven Dr (access from Rita Dr to Elray Rd) or a bit further down on Fieldcrest Rd. Both of these locations have sidewalks and there are three crossing guards posted in this area should anyone have to cross the street. Also, please be cognisant not to block driveways along Beachwood Rd or on any other street while you are waiting.
