## 5. Executive Directors

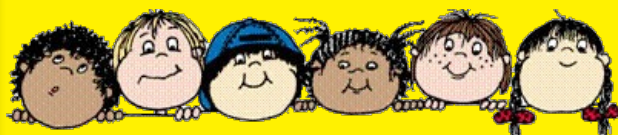
