Fourth Grade Curriculum

Expectations are high for all of our fourth grade students. Active participation in class as well as assuming responsibility for homework assignments are all part of being a successful student. Below you will find an overview of what our year will focus on:

Math: It is critical that your child knows their basic multiplication facts (0 -12). We will use the Go Math program to focus on: place value to one million, multiplying 1-digit and 2-digit numbers, dividing by 1-digit numbers, factors, multiples, fractions, decimals, angles, perimeter, area and more. Particular emphasis will also be placed on the steps to becoming proficient problem solvers.

Reading: We are implementing a balanced literacy program where we will utilize a Readers Workshop format. Our reading units will include: Interpreting Characters, Nonfiction, Historical Fiction Book Clubs, Solving the Mystery, Reading History (The American Revolution),

and Social Issues Book Clubs. Students will be required to read at least 20 minutes every night. Exposure to all the reading genres will be encouraged.

Writing: Fostering creative writers is our main goal and objective. The students will be honing their writing skills as they write their narrative, persuasive and expository pieces. The students' writing notebooks will become their new best friend! Writing across the curriculum will allow students ample opportunities to express their unique writing styles.

Science: This year, our scientists will be using a program called FOSS. It is directly aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) with a focus on STEAM activities. The units we will focus on are: engineering, soil/rocks/landforms, energy, and environments.

Social Studies: Our focus will be on the Regions of the United States and the global perspective of the world in which we live.

Social Emotional: We are focusing on social and emotional learning that involves developing competencies of diversity & inclusion, empathy & critical thinking, communication, problem solving, and peer relationships.
