Grade Guidelines for 4th Marking Period and Semester 2 (End of Year) during Remote Learning in 2020 due to Covid-19 School Closure

The grade guidelines below are a departure from Gloucester City's current grading policy. This grading procedure is developed **only** for use for the end of the 2019-2020 school year, due to a global health emergency requiring extended remote learning.

We will attempt to follow grading procedures that are as close to "normal" as possible given our current teaching and learning environment. Therefore, the number of assignments in a particular grading category may not necessarily match our grading criteria as outlined in the student handbook.

As we continue to social distance, we are adjusting the following to best support your child in the fairest way possible:

- There will be no stand-alone final exams this school year, even if we return to school this academic year.
- The Semester Two grade will be calculated as follows: 50% for MP3 and 50% for MP4.

We will all continue to work together to ensure that your child maximizes their learning and growth throughout the final six weeks of the school year in preparation for the roads that lie ahead of them on the way to college and career readiness. If we are unable to return to school buildings in June, the school district plans to offer virtual summer school for any students who do not successfully pass all courses in the core subject areas.
