Dear Parents/Guardians,

We want to thank our parents, staff and students for their input and ideas for the Alliston Boundary Review. At the Board of Trustees meeting on Monday, February 28th a final decision was made regarding boundary changes. These changes will come into effect September 2022.

The decisions were not made lightly, and we understand that change isn't always easy. Many of our schools are already over capacity and there is continued projected growth for the area. These changes were necessary in order to balance enrolment, plan the new Alliston Catholic elementary school and future growth.

A transition committee is being established to ensure that all affected students have access to the same supports and resources that they currently receive. This includes, but is not limited to Individual Education Plans, access to technology and school counsellor supports. The committee will also work to make this transition seamless and positive. Early next week, the affected families will receive a separate email with more information.

Approved Boundary Changes


- Students currently attending Monsignor J.E. Ronan who live north of Line 10 will be included in the boundary for the new Alliston Catholic Elementary School

St. Paul's

- Students currently attending St. Paul's who live east of County Road 10 will be included in the boundary for the new Alliston Catholic Elementary School

Father F.X. O'Reilly

- Beginning in September 2022, all students in Grades 7 and 8 who live within the Father F.X. O'Reilly Catholic School boundary will be relocated to Monsignor J.E. Ronan Catholic School.
