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Middle School Lesson Plan Format

{90 Minutes of Instruction}

OPENING

10 minutes

- Daily Review, Focus Activity

PROBLEM BASED LEARNING (SETTING THE STAGE)

20 minutes

- **Engage** - students know lesson objective and expectations
- **Explore** - interactive problem solving (small group/demonstration/modeling)
- **Summarize** - students share strategies and solutions

VISUAL LEARNING (TEACHER LED INSTRUCTION)

25 minutes

- **Engage** - utilize visual learning animations to set the purpose of the lesson
- **Explore** - guided practice (whole group)
- **Summarize** - independent practice (limited number of problems to show what you know)

ASSESS AND DIFFERENTIATE (SMALL GROUPS)

35 minutes

- **Intervention** - teacher-led
- **On-Level and Advanced** - independent
- **Summarize** - Quick Check to assess students' understanding
