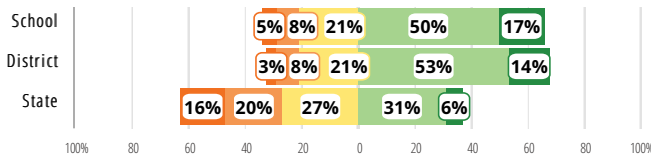

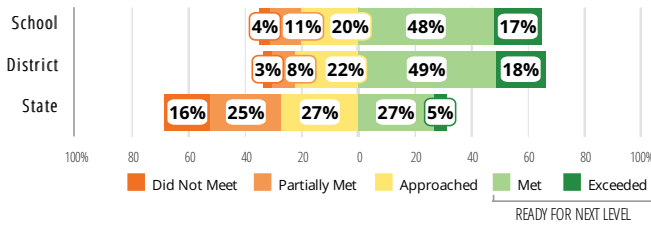
Academic Success

English Language Arts



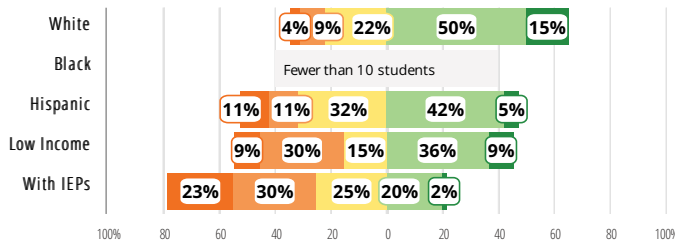

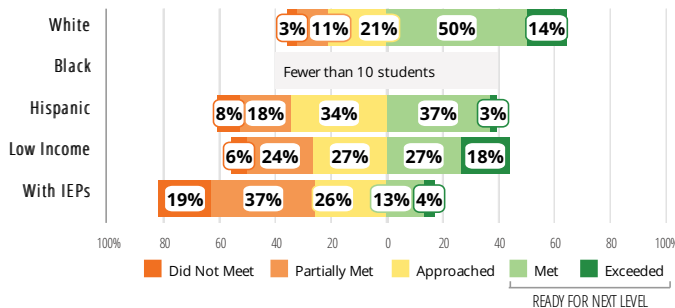
Success by Student Group

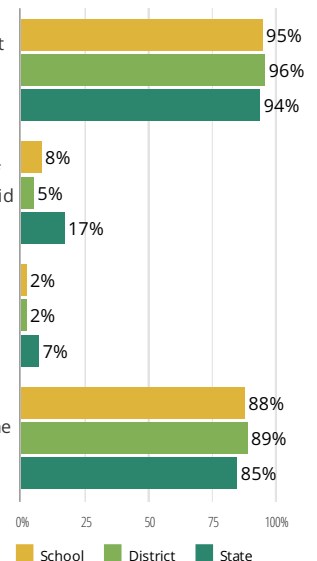

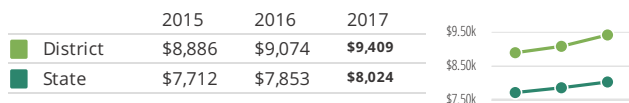

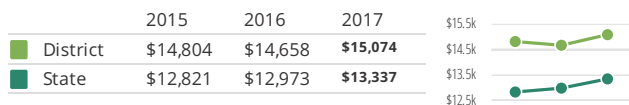
