Dear Madison Community,

We were notified of two Positive COVID-19 Cases at Madison High School. The district will not release the name of anyone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19, as this is protected health information.

Please note - this letter is just to inform you of the positive case. The Oakland County Health Department is aware of this positive case, and they will conduct the necessary steps to identify close contacts and notify those individuals/families.

Madison District Public Schools will support OCHD with information to support their case investigation. OCHD confirms the school's close contacts and notifies the parents of "Close Contacts" with any determined instructions to quarantine.

Any student who has been directed to quarantine by OCHD should contact the school office to appropriately code the absence.

As always, please monitor your child for any symptoms of COVID-19, which include fever, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and diarrhea. If your child does develop symptoms, please keep him or her home from school until they feel well enough to attend and have been fever-free for 24 hours.
