Student safety is the highest priority at King!

Please follow these important **PICK-UP** and **DROP-OFF** expectations

BEFORE SCHOOL PROCEDURES 4K through 5th Grades

- King Staff will utilize all but 4 parking spots in front of the school; 4 spots **ARE** reserved for extended visitor usage (marked by cones). Parents **ARE NOT** allowed to park in these spots before school. Parents **ARE** to use the side/auxiliary lot before school and the marked crosswalk to cross the parking lot.
- All vehicles will enter one way, traveling in one lane ONLY; **no parking, no passing**. Vehicles will stop/drop off passengers and continue to drive out of the circle lot in line with vehicles in front. **Adults are NOT to get out of their vehicle. Stop Drop and GO!**
- Buses/Daycare vans enter through this lane but will use the bus lane to exit passengers.
- Please Obey the posted signs "No Parking" and "No Stopping No Standing" in the neighborhood streets or you may be ticketed by the City of GB.....see definition below.

AFTER SCHOOL PROCEDURES 4K through 5th Grade

- Only buses, daycare vans and special marked vehicles may enter the circle drive to load passengers. Exit will be blocked with cones.
- All vehicles must remain parked until buses and day care van/traffic have safely left the parking lot. Designated school staff will be present to enforce and guide other traffic on school property.
- Highly recommend you have a (pre)designated meeting spot with your student(s); If your child is 4K, Kinder or first grade, you will need to find a parking spot and meet them on the lower playground.

City of Green Bay Parking Division DEFINITION for signs posted:

"NO PARKING" Means that you may legally pull up to the curb and park IF you are loading or unloading passengers & remain in attendance of your vehicle at all times.

"NO STOPPING OR STANDING" Means it is illegal for you to stop/pause/idle your vehicle under any circumstances in this posted zone. The City of GB will issue citations for any violation.

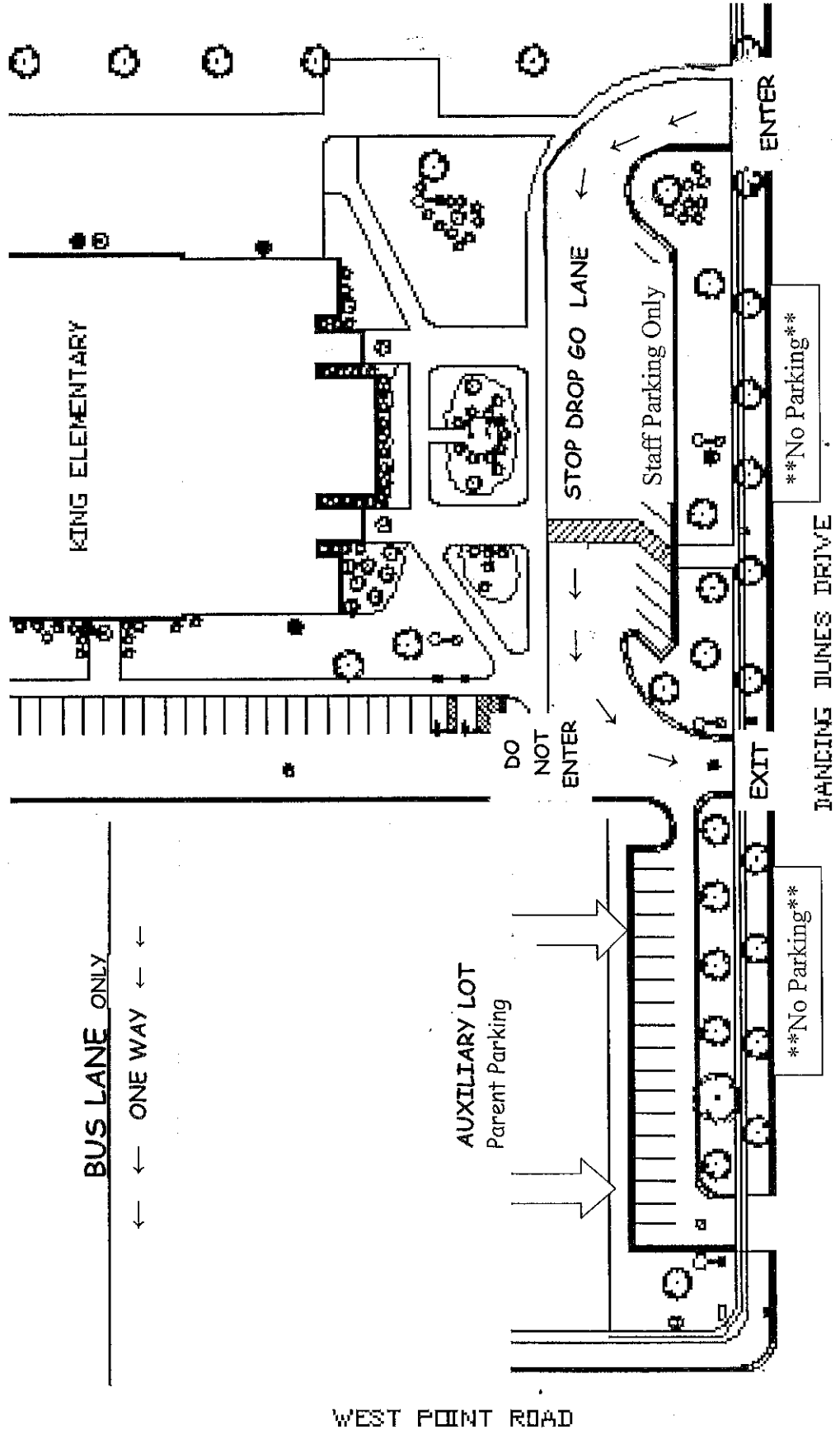
"ORANGE TRAFFIC CONES" - Designated areas that you must stop your vehicle or stay away from. Orange cones are used at the exit/entrances to allow for wide turns for our buses.

Please remember the King Staff supervising students before and after school are there to ensure the safety of all students, parents and staff. I ask that you be courteous to all staff and if you have questions or suggestions, please call or see me directly in the main office (492-2771). Dangerous driving, unkind or vulgar actions/language may result in a citation by police. Remember we are the role models for our children.

MORNING: ALL parents/guardians dropping their student off will enter one way and travel in one lane only, no passing, and travel all the way up to the STOP, DROP and GO sign by the main entrance. This allows maximum vehicles to enter and exit passengers at the same time. If you need to get out of your car (to help your child) then DO NOT use the STOP, DROP and GO lane. You will need to park in the lot and assist your child. This lane is only for children capable of getting out of the car by themselves using the right side of the car/vehicle for safety reasons.

AFTERNOON: Vehicles are NOT allowed on school campus. Parking is allowed in Auxiliary Lot (see map). If you happen to be parked in front of the school when the bell rings, you are required to remain parked until AFTER the buses and daycare vans leave. School personnel will signal when you may move your vehicle from the parking stall.
