2021-2022 Achievement Goals and Measures	
Literacy	<p>75% of students <i>at or above proficiency</i> according to the Benchmark Assessment System (BAS) May 2021 Independent reading level will make at least one year’s growth by May 2022. All students <i>below proficiency</i> according to the BAS May 2021 will either reach proficiency OR make 1.5 years growth. *Kindergarten’s growth will be assessed from Fall 2021 to May 2022. (This goal includes students who attend MacArthur School for the full academic year).</p>
Math	<p>75% of students in grades K-5 will score within the “meeting standard” range on the Number Corner Assessments (October, January and March) during the 2021-2022 school year.</p>
Engagement & Culture	<p>During the 2021-22 school year, 70% of students will receive an Eagle Eye Award which focuses on students demonstrating our PBIS expectations: SOAR. (Self-control, On task, Positive Attitude, Respect)</p>
Professional Learning Focus (Based on Needs Assessment)	
<p>During the 2021-22 school year, MacArthur teaching staff will focus our professional learning around Culturally Linguistic Responsiveness. Teachers in grades K-2 will receive training on foundational assessments to guide our phonics instruction. Teachers in grades 3-5 will adjust our reading performance assessment process and work to utilize the data collected to guide our instruction.</p>	
High Priority Strategies/Action Steps	
<p>Continued implementation of Lucy Calkins Reading and Writing Units of Study with fidelity at the universal level.</p>	
<p>Continued implementation of Bridges Math with fidelity at the universal level.</p>	
<p>Teachers in grades 4K-5 will create a Personalized Learning Plan (PLP) in Infinite Campus for students performing above or below grade level in literacy, math, and engagement. The PLP will be updated every 6-8 weeks following the progress monitoring meeting.</p>
