- 1 three-prong folder for Science, please select color by first letter of last name (A-E red, F-J green, K-O yellow, P-T blue, U-Z orange - Science teacher will collect)
- 4 packages No. 2 pencils (teachers will collect, label with student's name, and store in class)
- Eraser tops (Math class)
- 2 pack loose leaf paper (wide ruled)
- Blue and/or black pens
- Pencil case/box (will be carried to all classes)
- Colored pencils
- Earbuds (must have item, will be used in all core classes)
- 2 highlighters
- 4 pack Dry-erase markers (EXPO brand please—chisel point)
- 2 glue sticks
