



Daily Student Health Assessment

All parents/guardians of students participating in RLASD programs or activities are **required** to complete the Daily Student Health Assessment questionnaire below for each student participating in a school program **before leaving home each day**. This is to ensure the health and safety of all students and staff - your cooperation is greatly appreciated!

We recommend that you print this form and place it on your refrigerator or in another easily accessible place in your home to refer to each day.

Daily Assessment:

1. Is your child ill, or caring for someone who is ill? Symptoms to look for:
 - a. Fever over 100.4F or feeling feverish
 - b. Cough
 - c. Sore throat
 - d. Muscle or body aches
 - e. Vomiting, diarrhea or stomach pain
 - f. Change in smell or taste
 - g. Other symptoms
2. In the last 2 weeks, did your child care for or have close contact with someone diagnosed with COVID 19?

***If the answer to either question is "Yes", the student is **required to remain home** and report their absence to the secretary of the school. Ill students must remain home until one of the following occurs:

1. At least 10 days have passed since your symptoms started **AND** they have been symptom-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication..

OR

1. Written permission to return to school signed by the student's health care provider or the Barron County Public Health Department is presented to the building administrator or school nurse

Please note, if a student becomes ill while participating in school programming, the student will be isolated under supervision of a RLASD staff member with a face covering in place until parents are notified and pick up the student from school. **Due to limited space for ill students and to decrease the risk of spreading illness to others, we ask that parents pick up ill children within 30 minutes of being contacted by the school**. If we are unable to reach a parent or guardian the designated emergency contact person will be contacted and expected to pick up the student as soon as possible.

If your child is tested for COVID 19

- **Your child must remain home until you receive their test results AND**
 - If the test result is **POSITIVE** - follow the instructions from the Public Health Department regarding isolation and return to school
 - If the test result is **NEGATIVE** - student should remain home until symptom-free for 24 hours
