IMMUNIZATIONS

The Barron County Department of Health & Human Services-Public Health Programs offers immunizations through the **Wisconsin Vaccine for Children Program (VFC)**.

Please note: All children and adults may receive no cost **COVID-19** and **Pertussis (whooping cough)** at Public Health no matter what health insurance you have.

Immunizations for children who are eligible for the VFC program are provided at no charge. Parental consent is required for all children under 18 years of age.

Children who are VFC eligible include:

- Children through age 18 who are BadgerCare (Medicaid) eligible
- Children who are uninsured
- American Indian or Alaska native children
- Underinsured children (have health insurance but coverage does not include all vaccines or only covers selected vaccines.)

Children who have insurance that covers immunizations **cannot** be vaccinated at Public Health except for COVID-19 and Pertussis (whooping cough) vaccines. To check your insurance coverage, call the customer service number or contact your insurance provider. If immunizations are covered by your insurance policy, please schedule an appointment with your child's clinic.
