

COVID-19 Guidelines

School Wellness:

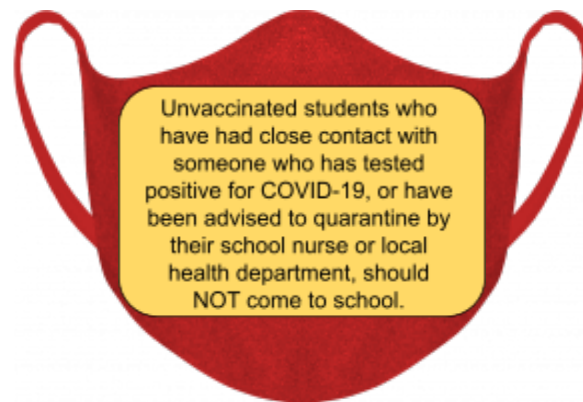
Don't place other students and staff at risk of becoming ill and increasing the likelihood that Hillsborough Township School District will need to close a classroom or school building.

DON'T SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IF SHE/HE HAS:

At least one of the following symptoms: Cough, Shortness of Breath, Difficulty Breathing, New loss of smell, New loss of taste.

OR

At least two of the following symptoms: Fever (100.0 or above), Chills, Rigors (shivers), Myalgia (muscle aches), Headache, Sore Throat, Diarrhea, Fatigue, Nausea or Vomiting, Congestion or runny nose.



*** Currently, according to our local COVID-19 Activity Level, unvaccinated siblings need to remain home.**

IF YOUR CHILD IS SICK AT SCHOOL:

- Students exhibiting any of the above symptoms during the school day will be placed in isolation in the health office. Parents/guardians will be notified to pick their child up (within 30 minutes of notification). **** Please ensure the contact information in Genesis is correct and up to date.**
- If your child is sent home with COVID-19-like symptoms, it is recommended that you contact your child's health care provider regarding a COVID-19 test.
- Unvaccinated siblings of the symptomatic student will be sent home and will not be able to return to school until COVID test results of the symptomatic student are received and reviewed by the school nurse.
- The current COVID-19 school exclusion protocol will be followed. This protocol is subject to change depending on the COVID activity level in our community and guidance from the Hillsborough Department of Health and our school physician.
- Parents/guardians of any student that tests positive for COVID-19 or has been advised to quarantine should notify the School Nurse.
- Parents/Guardians will be contacted by the school nurse and/or the Hillsborough Township Department of Health if their child has come in close contact with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 and will be given guidance.
- The district will continue to inform parents/guardians of all emergency communication through School Messenger and the district website.

*Please ensure that your child's school nurse has all current documentation including a copy of your child's COVID vaccination record if applicable.
